Business Seminar with Department of MSME, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh

The Embassy of India, Beirut organised a Virtual Business Seminar and B2B meeting on “Exploring Opportunities in Food and Agriculture Sector” in collaboration with Department of MSME, Madhya Pradesh on June 23, 2022. Hon’ble Minister of MSME, Madhya Pradesh Mr. Om Prakash Sakhlecha was Chief Guest in the Seminar. The Seminar was followed by Virtual B2B and Question and Answer Session. On the Lebanese side, the Seminar was attended by Mr. Hani El Bohsali, President of Syndicate of Importers of Agriculture Products, Mr. Mounir Teeny, Vice President, Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture of Zahle and Bekaa, Mr. Elie Massoud, Head of Agriculture Department, Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture of Beirut and Mount Lebanon, Mr. Mohammad Saleh, President of Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture of Sidon and South Lebanon, Mr. Tony Tohme, Head of Commercial Section, Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture of Zahle and Bekaa. Representative of Lebanon’s biggest grocery store, Spinneys and top businesspersons and importers from food sector also joined the Seminar.

2. Mr. Vishesh Garhpale, Director, Department of MSME, Madhya Pradesh gave welcoming remarks in which he gave overview about the State of Madhya Pradesh.

3. Mr. P. Narahari, Secretary, D/o MSME gave a detailed presentation on MSME sector in Madhya Pradesh with focus on Food and Agri sectors. He talked about the strength of MSME sector and potential of State of Madhya Pradesh. He appreciated such interactions between the buyer and seller to exchange views and create network.

4. In his remarks, Ambassador talked about overall strength of India that it is large country with huge availability of natural resources. State of Madhya Pradesh is the most agrarian state in the country. It is one of the largest producer of Soybean, pulses, chickpea, sesame, cotton, tomato, fruits.

There are many other products, which Madhya Pradesh can offer to Lebanon. He spoke about the trade figures of last few years and that the trade between India and Lebanon has increased 75% in the last financial year, as per figures from Lebanese data. Even if the total value of trade is modest but the trend is very positive. Indian exports to Lebanon increased from \$191 mn to \$313 mn in last financial year, as per figures from Indian side. With the increasing import from India, export from Lebanon to India is also increasing. This is the testimony of trust between the traders in India and Lebanon. He also mentioned about the contract between Ashok Leyland and Choureiry Group of Lebanon to bring Indian trucks into Lebanon's market. Also, presence of Bajaj Motorcycles in Lebanon. Lebanon is now big buyer of Indian mobile phones. He encouraged participants to connect with each other on this platform.

5. Hon'ble Minister Mr. Om Prakash Sakhlecha thanked the Embassy for reaching out to the Government of Madhya Pradesh and organising the Seminar and bringing the buyers and sellers together on one platform. He said that the Government of Madhya Pradesh is keen in this initiative to explore new business opportunities. He also said that Madhya Pradesh is the largest producer of pulses, guava, tomato and medicinal plants, especially herbs, as well as Tobacco. He also highlighted various policies of Govt of MP to enhance agriculture productivity. 42% population of the State is in the agriculture sector. The agriculture sector is developing very very fast. He extended all possible help to extend the trade relations with Lebanon.

6. Mr. Hani El Bohsali, President of Syndicate of Agriculture Products talked about the food security in Lebanon that it is the major issue due to financial crisis in Lebanon. The income of most of the Lebanese are affected greatly. He said that India is already a reliable partner but there is a need to enhance the trade relations between the two countries. He appreciated Embassy's efforts to organise and invite business persons for the Seminar. Mr. Mounir Teeny, Vice President of Chamber of Commerce, Industry and Agriculture of Zahle and Bekaa said that organising such seminar is a good step in right direction but there is a need to take a business delegation to India, since the covid restrictions are relaxed by most of the countries. I proposed him to participate in the trade exhibitions where there will be good opportunities to interact directly with the Indian sellers.

6. At the end of the Seminar, there was a B2B session between the Buyers and Sellers. The session was quite interactive. Traders from both sides participated with full interest. Lebanese businessmen, who are already doing business from India, shared their experience of purchasing high quality products at lower prices from India.

7. On this occasion, I also launched a booklet 'Geographical Indications of India', which the Embassy published (with data from the IBEF) to promote the GI products from India.

8. This is the first of its kind of event the Embassy has organised with a state. This is part of our State outreach activity as well.

Prime Minister's remarks at the session on 'Stronger Together: Addressing Food Security and Advancing Gender Equality' at G7 Summit in Germany

Excellencies,

We are meeting amid an atmosphere of global tension. India has always been in favour of peace. Even in the present situation, we have constantly urged for the path of dialogue and diplomacy. The impact of this geopolitical tension is not just limited to Europe. The rising prices of energy and food grains are affecting all the countries. The energy and security of developing countries is particularly at risk. In this challenging time, India has supplied food grains to many countries in need. We have dispatched about 35,000 tonnes of wheat as humanitarian aid to Afghanistan in the last few months. And even after the heavy earthquake there, India was the first country to deliver relief materials. We are also helping our neighbour Sri Lanka to ensure food security.

I have some suggestions on the subject of global food security. First, we must focus on the availability of fertilizers, and keep the value chains of fertilizers smooth at a global scale. We are trying to increase the production of fertilizers in India and seek cooperation from G7-countries in this regard. Second, India has immense agricultural manpower compared to the countries of the G7. Indian agricultural skills have helped give new life to traditional agricultural products like cheese and olive in some of the countries of the G7. Can the G7 create a structured system for the widespread use of Indian agricultural talent in its member countries? With the help of traditional talent of India's farmers, food security will be ensured to G7 countries.

Next year, the World is celebrating the International Year of Millets. On this occasion, we should run a campaign to promote a nutritious alternative like millets. Millets can make a valuable contribution to ensuring food security in the world. Finally, I would like to draw the attention of all of you to the 'natural farming' revolution taking place in India. Your experts can study this experiment. We have shared a non-paper on this subject with all of you.

Excellencies,

Where gender equality is concerned, today, India's approach is moving from 'women's development' to 'women-led development'. More than 6 million Indian women frontline workers kept our citizens safe during the pandemic. Our women scientists made a big contribution in developing vaccines and test kits in India. More than one million female volunteers in India are active in providing rural health, whom we call 'ASHA workers'. Just last month, the World Health Organization honoured these Indian ASHA workers with its '2022 Global Leaders Award'.

If all the elected leaders in India from local government to national government are counted, more than half of them are women, and the total number will be in millions. This shows that Indian women are fully involved in real decision-making today. Next year, India is going to chair the G20. We will maintain close dialogue with G7-countries on other issues, including post-COVID recovery, under the G20 platform.

تصريحات رئيس الوزراء في جلسة "معًا أقوى : معالجة الأمن الغذائي وتعزيز المساواة بين الجنسين" في قمة مجموعة السبع في ألمانيا

أصحاب السعادة،
نجتمع وسط أجواء يسودها التوتر العالمي. لطالما كانت الهند مؤيدة للسلام. حتى في الوضع الحالي، نحث باستمرار على اعتماد طريق الحوار والدبلوماسية. لا يقتصر تأثير هذا التوتر الجيوسياسي على أوروبا فقط بل أدى الى ارتفاع أسعار الطاقة والحبوب الغذائية وأثر على جميع البلدان. تتعرض طاقة البلدان النامية وأمنها للخطر بشكل خاص. في هذا الوقت الصعب، قدمت الهند الحبوب الغذائية للعديد من البلدان المحتاجة. لقد أرسلنا حوالي 35000 طنا من القمح كمساعدات إنسانية الى أفغانستان خلال الأشهر القليلة الماضية. وحتى بعد الزلزال القوي هناك، كانت الهند أول دولة تقدم مواد الإغاثة. كما أننا نعمل على مساعدة جارتنا سريلانكا لضمان الأمن الغذائي. لدي بعض الاقتراحات حول موضوع الأمن الغذائي العالمي. أولاً، يجب أن نركز على توافر الأسمدة، وأن نحافظ على مرونة سلاسل القيمة الخاصة بالأسمدة على نطاق عالمي. ففي الهند، نحاول زيادة إنتاج الأسمدة ونسعى للتعاون مع دول مجموعة السبع في هذا الصدد. ثانياً، تمتلك الهند قوى عاملة زراعية هائلة مقارنة بدول مجموعة السبع. ساعدت المهارات الزراعية الهندية في إعطاء حياة جديدة للمنتجات الزراعية التقليدية مثل الجبن والزيتون في بعض بلدان مجموعة السبع. هل تستطيع مجموعة الدول السبع إنشاء نظام منظم للاستخدام الواسع للمواهب الزراعية الهندية في البلدان الأعضاء فيها؟ فمن خلال الاعتماد على المواهب التقليدية للمزارعين في الهند، سيتم ضمان الأمن الغذائي لدول مجموعة السبع.

في العام المقبل، سيحتفل العالم بالسنة الدولية لحبوب الدخن. ففي هذه المناسبة، يجب أن نقوم بحملة للترويج لبديل مغذي مثل حبوب الدخن. فحبوب الدخن يمكن أن تقدم مساهمة قيمة في ضمان الأمن الغذائي في العالم. أخيراً، أود أن ألفت انتباهكم جميعاً إلى ثورة "الزراعة الطبيعية" التي تشهدها في الهند. يمكن لخبرائكم دراسة هذه التجربة. لقد شاركنا معكم ورقة غير رسمية حول هذا الموضوع.

أصحاب السعادة، عندما يتعلق الأمر بالمساواة بين الجنسين اليوم، ينتقل نهج الهند من "تنمية المرأة" إلى "التنمية التي تقودها المرأة". لقد حافظت أكثر من 6 ملايين امرأة هندية عاملة في الخطوط الأمامية على سلامة مواطنينا أثناء الجائحة. فقدمت عالماتنا مساهمة كبيرة في تطوير اللقاحات ومجموعات الاختبار في الهند. فأكثر من مليون متطوعة في الهند تنشط في توفير الصحة الريفية، ونسميهم "عاملات ASHA". في الشهر الماضي، كرمت منظمة الصحة العالمية عاملات ASHA بمنحهن "جائزة القادة العالميين لعام 2022".



Namda rugs sketch their roots from the land of Kashmir. To make these carpets, the wool is felted rather than weaved. Astonishing, isn't it? Usually, they include - plain & embroidered types of rugs. Namda is a major part of a Kashmiri household, and you can witness its existence in almost every household.



Khavda Pottery derives its origin from the state of Gujarat; the craftwork is practiced mainly in the North Kutch region. In the village named Khavda, it is considered one of the significant forms of art. 'Rann ki mitti' plays a crucial role in its crafting; it is obtained via lake, present around the village. Potters mould the soft clay in the desired shape, size, and product they want. Fauna, flora, bird motifs, and human figures are created on the water bottles, boxes, earthen pots, kettles, matkas, etc.

Manipur is strategically located in the North-eastern corner of India bordering Myanmar. The state serves as a corridor for India to the South East Asian countries and offers immense possibilities for growth of tourism and regional business. It is a land of festivals and almost every month the people of Manipur get together to celebrate various festivals which reflects its rich culture, traditions and religious practices. A diverse population that inhabits the state makes it apt to be called a mini India. The people of Manipur include Meitei, Nagas, Kuki-Chin-Mizos, Gorkhas, Muslims and other colourful communities which have lived in complete harmony for centuries. These are the people whose folklore, myths and legends, dances, indigenous games and martial arts, exotic handlooms and handicrafts are invested with the mystique of nature and an indefatigable feeling of happiness or excitement about life. The state has a travel friendly climate that makes anytime of the year favourable for visitors. The nine mountain ranges that surround the state prevent the cold winds from the north from reaching the valley and also act as a barrier to cyclonic storms from the Bay of Bengal.
